

Moonshine Trail (Red) Length: 1.8 miles Difficulty: Moderate


Trail begins and ends at Wildcat pavilion. This trail takes you through breathtaking woods, passing over numerous streams and along the ridges at Wildcat. Take time to investigate the old moonshine still just before the .5 mile marker on the right. Note: Moderate inclines are encountered along trail. Connects with Bobcat trail (blue) and connecting trail (green) to Wildcat Recreation Area, .6 miles.

Bobcat Trail (Blue) Length: 2.1 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Trail begins and ends at Wildcat pavilion. This trail begins with a gradual incline and takes you through the woods, ridges and valleys in Wildcat. Crossing several streams this trail winds back to join the Moonshine Trail. Note: Moderate inclines encountered along trail. Connects with Moonshine Trail (Red).


Walking Trails — — -Hiking Trails - - - (Brown)



Wildcat Trail (Red) Length: .8 miles Difficulty: Easy

Trail begins and ends at parking lot. Course circles Wildcat Recreation Area passing baseball, soccer fields and basketball court. Trail is paved.

Note: Steep incline at beginning and end. Connector trail (green) to Wildcat trails, .6 miles; connector trail (brown) to McDaniel Meadows trails, .3 miles. Gold paths access activities.



Meadows Trail (Blue) Length: .9 miles Difficulty: Easy to moderate

Trail begins and ends at parking lot. This trail leads you past meadows of wildflowers attracting many varieties of birds and butterflies crossing over two streams before the gentle decent to the end.

Note: Incline at .5 mile marker for approximately 100 feet. Connecting trail **(brown)** to Wildcat Recreation Area trail, .3 miles. **Gold** paths access neighborhood.

Dog Park Trail (Red) Length: .7 miles Difficulty: Easy to moderate

Trail beings and ends at parking lot. This trail winds through the wildflower meadows crossing two streams and passing by dog park area, joining the meadows trail.

Note: Incline at meadows trail .5 mile marker for approximately 100 feet. Connecting trail **(brown)** to Wildcat Recreation Area trail, .3 miles. **Gold** paths access neighborhood.
